



Rocket Science Hire Conditions

Background

Rocket Science, our Endeavour 24 Club Training Boat, is aimed at providing the opportunity for HBYC members, who don't own a boat, to race, train, or just go for a sail, on a responsive, competitive, smallish yacht

If a group of members wish to use Rocket Science they are required to nominate a "responsible person" (Skipper) who will take responsibility for the boat and its use from time of commencing launching to placement of the boat in its allocated space on the hard stand.

HBYC Club Member Hire

The rate for the hire of Rocket Science to club members as at 4th December, 2017 is \$60 per day.

Usage Conditions

The individual club member who hires Rocket Science takes sole responsibility for its use.

To use the HBYC Training Boat, the person responsible ("Skipper") for the use must:

1. Be a financial Senior or Crew HBYC member.
2. Have a minimum qualification equivalent to a Victorian General Marine Licence.
3. Ensure that all persons on board have either a current YA Silver Card or a Day Pass for the day they are sailing issued by the HBYC Manager.
4. Ensure that the appropriate safety gear required for the activity for which the boat is going to be used is on board and in serviceable condition.
5. Accept responsibility for any damage to Rocket Science during hire. All damage to Rocket Science by the Hirer will be charged to the member's account. If the damage is claimable under the Club Insurance Policy the maximum charge for damage is \$1000. Please note that damage to sails is not included in the Club Insurance Policy.

6. Not launch the training boat on training, Junior, or casual hire day when the BOM has issued a "Strong Wind Warning" or "Gale Warning". An alternative "hire" day may be organised in lieu of a hire cancelled when a BOM warning is in force. Exception to this condition is the occasion when the Training Boat has been hired by a crew to compete in a designated race the training boat may be sailed when a "Strong Wind Warning" has been issued. The boat shall not be launched or used if there is a current "Gale Warning".
7. Have undergone an Induction program or have person onboard who meets the requirements. This is to confirm the user has the necessary skills to launch Rocket Science from the hardstand, sail/motor from and to the concrete jetty and return Satie to the cradle in a safe manner. The induction can be organised through the office and there is allowance for recognition of prior learning (RPL) and experience.
8. Rocket Science not to be launched, under any circumstances by any Club Member, unless the Hire Form is completed and the signed document delivered or e mailed to the Office before Rocket Science is launched,
